Post-conference Whale Watch

We have organized a whale watch on 22 June (the day after the conference ends) through "Capt. Bill's Whale Watch" out of Gloucester, MA. Gloucester is about a 45 min drive from Durham. Capt. Bill's works with and is endorsed by the Whale Center of New England (formerly known as the Cetacean Research Unit) and has a 99.9% sighting record. Vans will leave from Durham at 9:00 am and return at approximately 4:00 pm. The whale watch begins at 10:30 am and lasts for about 4 hrs. Group rates (including \$7/person to cover costs of vans) are \$24 for adults and \$17 for seniors (60+) and children (15 and under). More information about Capt.
