In response to many member requests, we've scheduled a tour of the Harvard Art Museums. Harvard Art Museums comprise three museums: the Fogg Museum, the Busch-Reisinger Museum, and the Arthur M. Sackler Museum; they were integrated into a single institution in 1983.

The Fogg Museum is renowned for its holdings of Western paintings, sculpture, decorative arts, photographs and prints from the Middle Ages to the present. The Busch-Reisinger Museum is the only museum in North America dedicated to the study of art from the German-speaking countries of Central and Northern Europe (in all media and in all periods). The Arthur M. Sackler Museum, named for its major donor, holds important collections of Asian art, archaic Chinese jades as well as Japanese surimono (woodblock prints), Chinese bronzes, ceremonial weapons, ceramics from China and Korea, and Japanese lacquer boxes.
