



UNH-Durham Rail Station Advance Project Start Notice

The Rail Station renovation is scheduled to begin on or soon after **Monday, September 10, 2007.**

Work will affect Depot Street and sidewalks/paved areas adjacent to the station (excluding the building itself). Vehicular access to the Whittemore Center and municipal lot will be maintained; however, users should expect delays, detours, dust and noise during six to eight weeks of construction.

- The Dairy Bar restaurant will remain open during this work with access available for walk-in patrons.
- Platform access will be maintained for train passengers but there will be no vehicular drop-off/pick-up at the immediate platform site. Train patrons should plan a few extra minutes to access the platform. Train boarding may be limited to the upper platform as construction progresses.
- Expect meter, ADA and reserved parking space closures on Depot Street and Lot Z during the construction period for UNH owned paved areas adjacent to the station. Violators may be ticketed and/or towed. Please contact University Transportation Services for lot regulations and status.
- ADA and reserved spaces in the adjacent municipal lot are not affected. Please note that the municipal lot is all-reserved and subject to Town enforcement. For information on permits, enforcement or regulations regarding this lot, please consult the Town of Durham website.
- Special event parking will also be affected in the immediate work area. Please follow signage and/or special event traffic safety directions on-site.

Work on the renovation of the rail station building itself will commence later this semester.
