REQUIREMENTS FOR SATELLITE ACCUMULATION AREA (SAA)

- Do you know your responsibilities for the proper handling of hazardous waste?
 - Please review the following requirements to ensure that you comply with environmental regulations.
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Container Management:

- Good, non-leaking and closed.
 - Container is compatible with the waste stored in it (i.e., glass for acids)
 - Separate containers holding incompatible materials.
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Container Labeling:

- All containers must be labeled with a University of New Hampshire hazardous waste label.
- Hazardous waste labels must be clearly visible and legible.

Each hazardous waste label must contain:

- All hazardous constituents (no abbreviations or chemical formulas).
 - The beginning accumulation date (date when waste was first placed in container).
 - The building/laboratory information at the bottom of the label.
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Container Closure:

- Hazardous waste containers must be closed at all times during storage, except when waste is being added or removed.
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Storage:

- All hazardous waste containers must be stored within secondary containment.
 - Containers must be stored on an impervious surface.
 - Posted emergency information (i.e., personnel contact and phone number). Typically, the signage at the laboratory entrance is adequate.
