For evaluation please be sure to bring your pet's rabies certificate (obtained from your veterinarian – we will not evaluate without it), the handler questionnaire from the back of your book or from your renewal packet, and your animal's brush.

From points South:

- Take Route 95 North to New Hampshire.
- Take Exit 2 (Exeter, Manchester, Hampton Beach) to Route 101 West.
- Take Route 101 West to Exit 11 (Stratham, Newmarket).
- Turn left at end of ramp onto Portsmouth Avenue (Route 108 South).
- At second set of traffic lights, turn left onto Alumni Drive (Exeter Hospital Main Campus).*

From points North:

- Interstate 95 South to New Hampshire.
- Take Exit 2 (Exeter, Manchester, Hampton Beach) to Route 101 West.
- Take Route 101 West to Exit 11 (Stratham-Newmarket).
- Turn left at end of ramp onto Portsmouth Avenue (Route 108 South).
- At second set of traffic lights, turn left onto Alumni Drive (Main Campus).*

From Manchester:

- Route 101 East toward Portsmouth.
- Take Exit 11 (Stratham, Newmarket, Portsmouth).
- Turn right at end of ramp onto Portsmouth Avenue (Route 108 South).
- At second set of traffic lights, turn left onto Alumni Drive (Main Campus).*

From Nashua:

- Take Route 111 East to Exeter's downtown area.
- At the bandstand, turn right onto Water Street.
- Turn left at first set of traffic lights onto Portsmouth Avenue (Route 108 North).
- At second set of traffic lights, turn right onto Alumni Drive (Main Campus).

*** FOR ALL ONCE YOU ARE ON THE MAIN CAMPUS:**

- Take your FIRST LEFT (as if you were going to the parking garage).
- Drive PAST the entrance to the garage and continue straight.
- Exeter Healthcare will be directly in front of you.
- Park in the front parking lot (on your left) and come in the main entrance.
- Lisa will have a table set up to greet you prior to your evaluation session (if she is not at the table when you come in, please have a seat in the waiting area, and she will be right with you).
