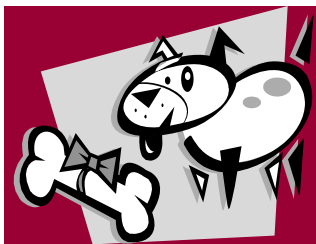




## PET FOOD DONATIONS

## FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Financial contributions are used in many ways:

- We use financial contributions to purchase pet food when donations do not carry us through or when a pet needs a special diet.
- We use contributions to help subsidize the cost of medication for our clients' pets.
- We use donations to help defray the cost of Pet Partner's training for our volunteers, instructors, and evaluators.
- **Veterinary Care Loan Fund** –We have established a modest fund from which clients could borrow funds for unexpected and expensive veterinary care for their pets and pay back interest free on a manageable schedule.
- As we grow and are able to accept more clients and train and provide resources for more volunteers, we always need contributions for our general operating expenses.

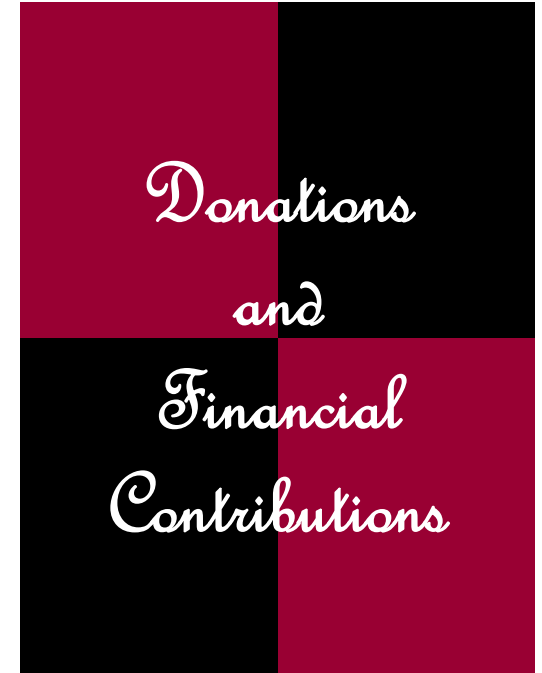
