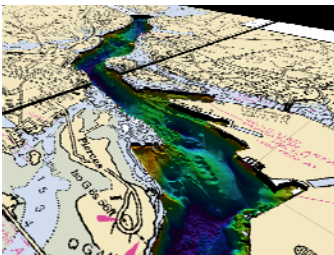


The NASA STEREO satellites are launched in October, 2006 from Cape Canaveral with UNH Space Science Center instruments on board.

- The Interoperability Lab

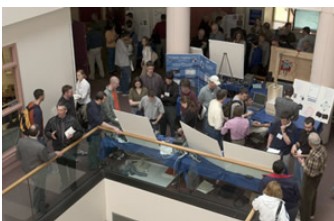
