Steven A. Zyck has extensive experience as a researcher and expert practitioner in aid delivery in conflict-affected and insecure environments. He is currently a Faculty Associate at the Center for Conflict and Humanitarian Affairs at the Doha Institute, Qatar. Zyck also works with the following organizations: the Overseas Development Institute (ODI), the Centre for Security Governance, the Post-war Reconstruction and Development Unit (PRDU) at the University of York, and the Institute for Governance and Policy Analysis at the University of Canberra. He is also associated with Humanitarian Outcomes, a policy-research organization.

Steven Zyck has published articles in peer-reviewed journals such as *Disasters*, *Conflict, Security & Development*, *Contemporary Security Policy* and *Third World Quarterly*. He has also contributed policy papers to institutions such as the World Bank, NATO, various UN agencies and the London School of Economics. Zyck has regional expertise in Yemen and throughout the Middle East, and regularly appears on media outlets such as Al Jazeera, BBC, CNN and CNBC. He is the founder and former editor of the open-access publication [Stability: International Journal of Security & Development](#). Steven Zyck has an MA with Distinction in Post-war Recovery from the University of York.
