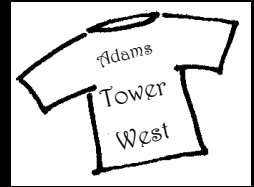

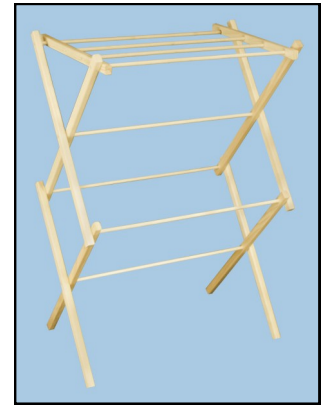

Clothes Drying Racks Available!

Save yourself some cash (and some energy!) by signing out one of the hall's 3 clothes drying racks from the laundry room. Why a Drying Rack instead of a dryer?

*The average student spends at least .80 cents per week drying their laundry. If you used drying racks instead, you could save \$13 every semester. What could you do with an extra \$13 each semester?

*Dryers use a huge amount of energy to do their job. Almost 6% of all residential electric energy is used by clothes dryers. Lets cut back!

*Afraid of shrinking your clothes? Laying your jeans and sweaters on a drying rack instead of throwing them in the dryer will spare you the frustration of shrinking your duds.

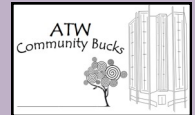
Meetings last one hour and are a great way to meet hall-mates, ask questions and build community.. New members always welcome at hall Council!
