

DIRECTIONS TO PAUL CREATIVE ARTS CENTER, UNH, DURHAM, NH

From the Boston area

Follow Rt. 95 North. As you approach Portsmouth you will see a sign for a left exit saying:
Exit 4, Spaulding Turnpike
Rts. 4 & 16
New Hampshire Lakes & White Mountains

Bear left when you see that sign. Follow this road for about 4 miles.

*****Take exit 6W. This turn-off (the last exit before toll) takes you directly onto Rt. 4 West. Stay on this road for about 6 miles to a stop light. This is Madbury Road. Just before this is a sign for the New England Center Hotel. Get into left turn lane and turn left onto Madbury Road.

@@@@ Go to the stop sign (about 6/10ths of a mile). Turn right onto Edgewood Road. Go to the stop sign (again about 6/10ths of a mile). Turn left onto Main Street. Go about 4/10ths of a mile and turn right onto Mill Road. Go 2/10ths of a mile and turn right onto AcademicWay. Paul Creative Arts Center is 2/10ths of a mile on your right.

From Maine – Kittery, Portland, etc.

Come south on Rt. 95. Leave Rt. 95 at Exit 5. Follow signs toward Rt. 4 West and Durham. Follow this road for about 4 miles. The rest of the directions are the same as above from Boston after *****.

From Manchester, N.H.

Follow Rt. 101 East to Exit 7, Rt. 125. Take Rt. 125 North to the intersection of Rt. 4 which is a traffic Circle. Pick up Rt. 4 East there. &&&& Proceed on Rt. 4 until you come to the Madbury Road traffic light (the only stop light around for miles). Turn right on Madbury Road. The rest of the directions are the same as above from Boston after @@@@.

From Concord, N.H.

Follow Rt. 4 East from Concord. Stay on Rt. 4 all the way (past 125 & 4 traffic Circle). The rest of the directions are the same as above under Manchester after &&&&.

From Burlington, Vt. and Hanover, N.H.

Take I89 South to Concord, N.H. Take I93 North to exit 15E (Rt. 393). Follow 393 to end (about 2 miles). It merges directly with Rt. 4 East. The rest of the directions are the same as above from Concord, N.H.

Parking

Since it is Saturday, all lots that are labeled for staff, faculty, or student use are available for the general public. Lot B is the easiest to find. There is a lot behind Parsons and meters in front of the PCAC that are free on Saturdays. Traffic pattern to the meters in front of PCAC has changed.

Directions to Bratton Recital Hall, PCAC

Enter the main door to Paul Creative Arts Center that is located on College Road. Head straight back, passing the University Art Gallery. Go as far as you can until you reach a staircase. Go down the stairs and the Bratton Recital Hall, M-135, is on your right. There are a lot of large signs posted in PCAC that help direct you to the Bratton.
