The Broadband USA site has a [map](http://www2.ntia.doc.gov/BTOPmap/) (<http://www2.ntia.doc.gov/BTOPmap/>) available to help people visualize the progress being made by the Broadband Technology Opportunities Program (BTOP).

There are over 200 BTOP projects across all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and U.S. Territories working to improve broadband connectivity across the country. BTOP Grantees are reporting progress in their plans to connect institutions, communities, and people.

Network New Hampshire Now has committed to connecting 220 Community Anchor Institutions (CAIs), including educational institutions, libraries, healthcare facilities, and public safety entities to the new high speed network.

The network currently being built in New Hampshire is the first step to bringing broadband access closer to residents and businesses. It's much like the interstate highway system, and upon completion internet service providers can use the network to build the "off ramps" to extend the network to your communities.
