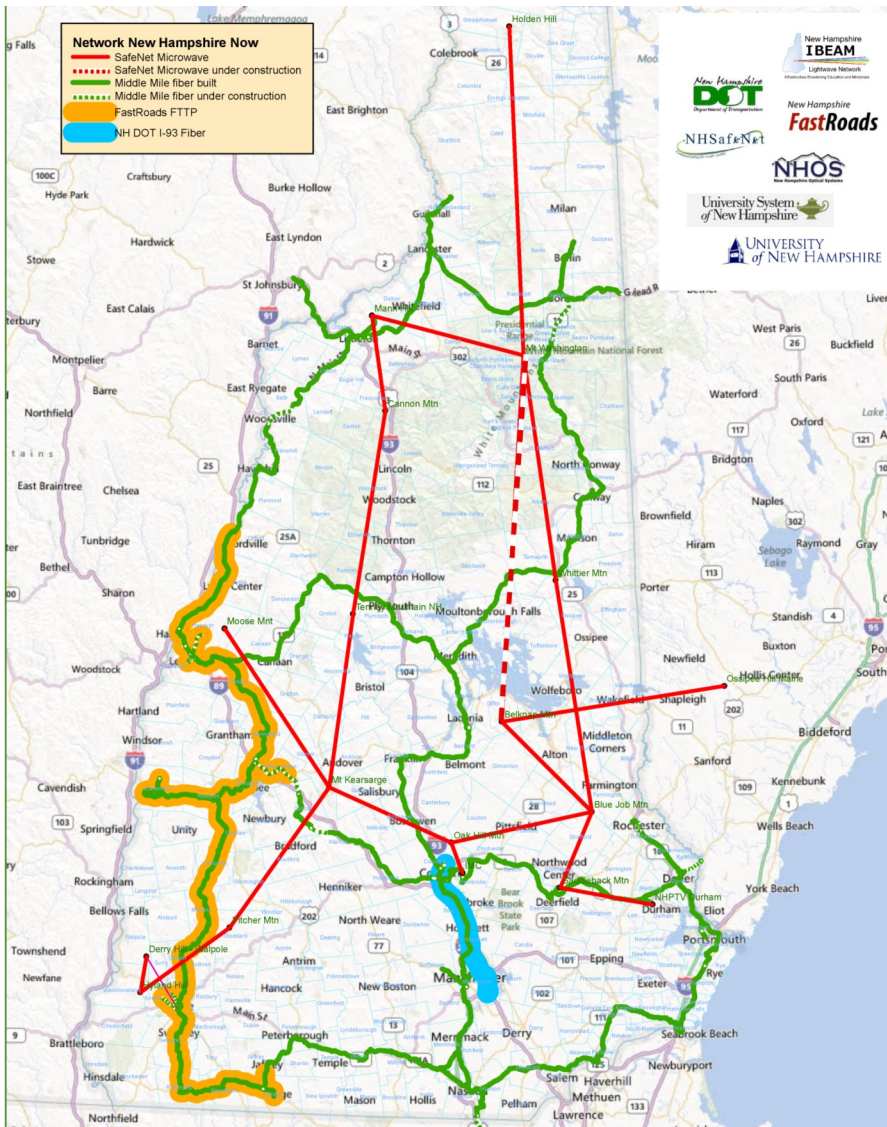

## CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS UPDATE



Current construction status on the Network NH Now project

*Much has been accomplished since last spring. Here are a few highlights:*

### Middle Mile Progress

- ⇒ 705 Miles of NHOS Fiber Constructed
- ⇒ 20 miles of NH DOT Middle Mile fiber completed June 2013.
- ⇒ 16 Community Anchor Institutions currently directly connected to fiber
- ⇒ 60 Community Anchor Institutions will be connected by December 2013
- ⇒ 5 Internet Service Providers are currently leasing fiber
- ⇒ Entire network to be completed in Fall 2013

### Microwave Network Progress

- ⇒ 19 Microwave sites have cut over to the new NH SafeNet broadband microwave network
- ⇒ 5 NH agencies now share common infrastructure. The network is managed by the NH Department of Safety State Police Communications.
- ⇒ NH Public Television and NH State police are testing the new datacasting network to be in place by September 2013

### Last Mile Progress

- ⇒ 78 Miles of fiber constructed
- ⇒ 230 Community Anchor Institutions currently being spliced into the NH FastRoads Network
- ⇒ 1,186 homes in Enfield and Rindge will be able to be connected by December 2013. 580 residences have signed connection agreements.
- ⇒ 3 Internet Service Providers have signed up to use the NH FastRoads Last Mile network.
