Park in Lot A – No permit need.

Students check-in at Stoke Hall between 11:30 and 1 PM . Thompson School students should go directly to Barton Hall. Parents should check-in at the Memorial Union Building (the MUB) between 12 noon and 1 PM. Both programs end by 12 noon on day II

Handicap Parking

Handicap parking spaces are adjacent to campus buildings where orientation programs occur. To use them, you must display a current Handicap Permit (state placard).

Shuttle Service

Shuttle services runs from lot A to Stoke and the Memorial Union Building on Day I from 11:30 AM – 1:30 PM and 5:30 – 6:15 PM and on Day II from 7:30 – 9:00 AM
