Pre-Dental Student Award**

The New Hampshire District 1 chapter of the International College of Dentists presents this award annually to a UNH junior or senior **pre-dental** student with a demonstrated balance of a) excellence in academic achievement, b) community service, c) leadership potential, and d) the drive and determination to become a highly competent and respected dentist. Financial need is not a factor. The recipient will be announced this (spring) semester. The award will be presented Fall 2009.

1. Be a UNH student registered with the Health Professions Advising Office.
2. Have a minimum of 58 earned credits.
3. **Have an active application file with the Advising Office.**
(Limited to those applying to Dental School for the 2009 and 2010 application cycles)
4. Complete the International College of Dentists-NH District 1 Pre-Dental Student Award Application.
5. Write a letter of introduction addressed to the 'ICD Awards Committee' that includes:
 - A personal statement detailing personal experiences and events that have influenced and motivated your decision to pursue a career in medicine.
 - A summary of your academic experiences, goals, and accomplishments relevant to the scholarship criteria that you believe make you a competitive applicant.
6. Include a resume that includes work experiences, extracurricular activities, academic honors and awards, and other pertinent information.

7. Submit the Judicial Conduct* form to **UNH Judicial & Mediation Programs Office, Hitchcock Hall** * **If you have submitted a conduct form for your 2010 Application File to dental school, you do not need to submit a new form.**
