

REGISTRATION CALENDAR, SEMESTER I, 2011-2012

August

- 15, Mon. **LAST DAY** for presenting final copies of Ph.D. dissertation or Master's Thesis to Graduate School for binding (**September 2011 graduation**).
- 26, Fri. **LAST DAY** to withdraw or drop courses and qualify for 100% refund.

- 1, Thurs. **Summer Graduation date – no ceremony**
- 5, Mon. Labor Day, University Holiday
- 6, Tues. **LAST DAY** for graduate students to register **without** \$25 late registration fee.
