

# REGISTRATION CALENDAR, SEMESTER II 2008-2009

## January

- 19, Mon Martin Luther King, Jr., Day, University Holiday  
**LAST DAY** to withdraw or drop courses and qualify for 100% refund  
Undergraduate web registration ends at 6:00 p.m.
- 20, Tues **Classes begin, follow TUESDAY schedule**
- 27, Tues **LAST DAY** for grad students to register **without** \$25 late registration fee  
Graduate web registration ends at 6:00 p.m.
- 30, Fri **LAST DAY** for grad and undergrad students to withdraw, to drop to part-time, or to reduce part-time load and qualify for 3/4 tuition refund (based on 3/4 difference in tuition)

## February

- 6, Fri **LAST DAY** to add courses or Honors designation  
**LAST DAY** to drop courses, or Honors designation or change to audit **without** \$25 per course late fee  
**LAST DAY** for graduate students to register and pay without having degree status discontinued  
**LAST DAY** to choose Pass/Fail grading option
- 13, Fri **LAST DAY** for **May 2009** undergraduate degree candidates to file an Intent-to-Graduate **without** \$25 late fee
- 20, Fri **LAST DAY** for graduate & undergraduate students to **withdraw**, to **drop to part time**, or to **reduce part-time load** and qualify for **1/2 tuition refund (based on 1/2 difference in tuition)**  
**LAST DAY** to **drop** courses or change to **audit** (\$25 per course **late fee** continues to apply)  
**LAST DAY** to carry **excess of credits without** surcharge  
**LAST DAY** to drop Honors designation

## March

- 13, Fri **MID-SEMESTER**  
**LAST DAY** to **withdraw** from the University **without** receiving grades of **WP** or **WF**  
**LAST DAY** for **graduate** students to file an Intent-to-Graduate for **May 2009 without** \$25 late fee  
Residence Halls close for Spring Recess, 7:00 p.m.  
Deadline for **undergraduate level** coursework resolving **Fall 2008 IC** grades. Petitions for extensions are due in the students' deans' offices.

## March Continued

- 16, Mon - **SPRING RECESS**
- 20, Fri
- 23, Mon Classes resume
- 27, Fri **LAST DAY** to file an Intent-to-Graduate for **May 2009** with a \$25 late fee.  
Special grade reports resolving **IC** grades from **Fall 2008** are due in Registrar's Office for all undergraduates and all other students with **IC** grades in 400 through 700 level courses.  
Petitions for extensions are due in the Registrar's Office.  
**Unresolved ICs** will be converted to **Fs**

## May

- 4, Mon **LAST DAY** announced written or oral exams may be given **before** finals
- 8, Fri **LAST DAY** for presenting final copies of Ph.D. dissertation or master's thesis to Graduate School for binding (**May 2009 graduation**).
- 11, Mon **LAST DAY** of classes  
Deadline for **graduate level** coursework resolving **Fall 2008 IC** grades. Petitions for extensions are due in the Graduate School, Thompson Hall  
**LAST DAY** to file completion of minor form for May graduates  
**LAST DAY** to change college until June
- 12, Tues Reading Day
- 13, Wed Reading Day
- 14, Thurs Final Exams begin
- 18, Mon Special grade reports resolving **Fall 2008 IC** grades are due in the Graduate School for all graduate degree and non-degree students with **IC** grades in **800- or 900- level courses**.  
Unresolved **ICs** will be converted to **F**.
- 21, Thurs Final Exams end
- 22, Fri Senior Day
