SOCIOLOGY MAJOR: To declare a major in sociology, students must have completed an introductory sociology with a grade of C or better. Declared majors must complete a minimum of 40 semester credits with a grade of C- or better in each course and a grade-point average of 2.00 in all sociology courses. SOC 400, 502 (or acceptable substitutes), 599, 601, and 611 are required. At least two of the additional major courses must be at the 600- or 700-level. SOC 502 is a prerequisite for 601; SOC 599 must be completed no later than the junior year and is a prerequisite for majors taking 600- and 700-level courses.
