

Moving off campus? Before you sign a lease, know your (parking) rights!



- As an off-campus housed student you are not eligible to keep (or buy) a UNH *campus resident* parking permit.
- You may buy (or exchange your resident permit for) a *commuter* parking permit if you move to an eligible address.
- You are not eligible to get (or keep) a commuter parking permit if your off-campus address is:
 - ...less than 1 mile from T-Hall, or
 - ...less than ¼ mile from an existing in-town Wildcat Transit or Campus Connector bus stop.

UNH does not provide resident/overnight parking for off-campus living accommodations. Excellent public transit options exist for ineligible addresses, as well as for any inter-city commuting. Other eligibilities/exchange policies apply. Contact UTS for details.
