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Technical Report

How the Sample Was Selected

The sample used in this survey was provided by the University of New Hampshire and consisted of a systematic random sample of students (living on- and off-campus), faculty and staff at the University of New Hampshire in Durham, NH.

When the Interviewing Was Done

Respondents in the University of New Hampshire 2001 Transportation Survey were interviewed between May 1 and May 8, 2001. Each selected respondent was called by a professional UNH Survey Center interviewer from a centrally supervised facility at the UNH Survey Center. Telephone calls during the field period were made between 9:00 AM and 9:00 PM.

Attempts were made to contact fourteen hundred, ninety-five (1495) UNH students and one thousand, one-hundred, eighty-six (1186) UNH faculty/staff. Table 1 shows the percentage of the student contacts which resulted in completed interviews (27%), refusals (3%), failures to interview because the telephone was busy, the phone was not answered, the telephone was answered by an answering machine, appointments were broken, or the respondent was away on business, on vacation, or otherwise unavailable during the interviewing period (53%), or because the student was no longer a UNH student, or the number was changed or disconnected (17%).

Table 2 shows the percentage of the student contacts which resulted in completed interviews (34%), refusals (4%), failures to interview because the telephone was busy, the phone was not answered, the telephone was answered by an answering machine, appointments were broken, or the respondent was away on business, on vacation, or otherwise unavailable during the interviewing period (58%), or because the faculty or staff member was no longer a UNH faculty or staff member, or the number was changed or disconnected (5%).

Table 3 shows the percentage of the total contacts (both student and faculty/staff) which resulted in completed interviews (30%), refusals (3%), failures to interview because the telephone was busy, the phone was not answered, the telephone was answered by an answering machine, appointments were broken, or the respondent was away on business, on vacation, or otherwise unavailable during the interviewing period (55%), or because the faculty or staff member was no longer a UNH faculty or staff member, or the number was changed or disconnected (12%).
