Portland, ME and Portland International Jetport

Take the Downeaster north to Portland Transportation Center (PTC). Twice hourly Portland Metro #5 bus service available to Portland International Jetport and downtown. At PTC, connect to Concord Trailways (see above) for routes to north coastal Maine communities. Work in progress to extend Downeaster north to Brunswick, ME and connect with Maine Eastern Railroad service to Rockland. **The Portland Airport is also just a 10 minute taxi ride from the Portland Transportation Center station.**
