"I began my time in the Wildcat Battalion as the Officer in Charge of Bravo Company at the University of Southern Maine nearly two years ago. This year, as the S3 and primary MSIII instructor, my workload is intense but also immensely rewarding. As the Battalion S3 I work primarily with the MSIVs to manage the training calendar, plan and coordinate all of our labs, field training exercises, and other major training events. Another aspect of my role in the planning and execution is primarily as a mentor. This role has allowed me to develop a close relationship with our senior class that remains hugely important to me, and I'm excited to see their careers unfold. This year's sizeable MSIII class is also making rapid progress toward Advanced Camp.
