### Student IDs & SSN's

- Students assigned randomly-generated ID numbers and ID cards.
- Social Security Numbers are needed by UNH for federal tax credits and Financial Aid.
- If the SSN has not already been provided, complete
   W9S form available from Student Accounts

# **Billing Cycle**

- Regular Monthly Billing Schedule:
  - Bills available on the 10<sup>th</sup>
    - (Fall charges will be included on the July 10<sup>th</sup> statement)
  - Due on the 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Late fees applied on the 5<sup>th</sup>



### **UNH Parent Portal**

- Student account information is protected by federal privacy laws (FERPA)
- Students create Parent Portal accounts in Webcat
  - Options include Billing, Financial Aid, and/or Final Grades

### **Student Health Insurance**

- Required by State of NH for full-time students
- \$1,140/semester premium is automatically charged to student accounts
- Premium may be waived if a student has comparable plan from parent or employer
- Waiver/enrollment form opens in mid-June <u>http://unh.edu/shbp</u>



### **Miscellaneous Course Fees**

- Some courses require additional fees
  - Excursion fees
  - Certification exams
  - Lab equipment
- Charges will be applied directly to the bill

# **Paying the Bill**

### Pay online through Webcat or Parent Portal

- E-check payments no fee
- Debit/credit card payments 2.85% non-refundable service fee
- Paper check payments should be made payable to 'UNH' and can by sent by mail to:

UNH Student Accounts 11 Garrison Avenue Durham, NH 03824

Always include the student's name and UNH ID number



### **Monthly Payment Plan**

### Five payments per semester

- Fall: July November
- Spring: December April
- Payments will be automatically withdrawn from checking account (no fee) or credit card (2.85% service fee)
- Access payment plan through Webcat & Parent Portal
- \$60 enrollment fee/semester, but interest-free



### **Outside Scholarships**

- Scholarships will be credited when the check arrives in our office
- Co-paid checks must be signed by the student before sending to UNH
- Include award letters with the check



### 529 Accounts/College Saving Accounts

- Request payment immediately!
- Payments most often come as <u>paper checks</u> and generally take several weeks to arrive
- Always include the student's name and ID number

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Estimated Aid/Verification



### **Types of Financial Aid**

### <u>Grants</u>

- Do not have to be repaid
- Will be a pending credit on tuition bill
- Need-based
- Merit based



# **Types of Financial Aid (cont.)**

### Work Study

- Not a credit on tuition bill
- Student searches for job <u>unh.edu/career/handshake</u>
- Job not guaranteed
- Paycheck every two weeks

# **Types of Financial Aid (cont.)**

Direct Loans

- Subsidized
  - Need-based
  - No interest until repayment
- Unsubsidized
  - Non-need based
  - Interest begins once funds are disbursed



# **Types of Financial Aid (cont.)**

### Direct Loans

- Complete Master Promissory Note (MPN) at: <u>https://studentaid.gov</u>
- Complete Entrance Counseling at: <u>https://studentaid.gov</u>
- 4.99% interest / origination fee (1.057%)
- Pending credit on tuition bill



- One-time adjustment to income




### Reminders

- Apply for aid each year starting October 1<sup>st</sup>
- March 1 priority deadline
- Use the Data Retrieval Tool
- Change in income/assets/# in college will lead to change in EFC and aid
