## **To our McConnell Office**

- From Boston or N. Massachusetts, take 128 to I-95 or 495 North, to Portsmouth NH, take exit 4, which exits to the left to get onto Rte. 16 North Spaulding Turnpike.
- (If coming from Portsmouth, NH) Get onto Rte. 16 North Spaulding Turnpike.)
- Go 4 or 5 miles to Exit 6W, labeled "Concord, Highway 4". Just before the toll plaza.
- Follow Route 4 West 3.7 miles. Exit on Route 108 (on right). Turn left onto Route 108 toward Durham.
- Go straight into town (bearing right after a cluster of gas stations). Continue bearing right past the Post Office. Get in left lane, bear left at first median, and continue bearing left at second median onto Main Street (the Aroma Joes and Subway will be on your left). Move into right lane and bear right (after the bus stop) onto Mill Road. Durham Shopping Plaza will be on your left and a medium sized parking Lot "C" will be on your right.
- Continue for about ¼ mile, and take first right onto Academic Way (tan house on the corner).
- Our building, McConnell Hall, is about 200 yards down Academic Way, the first 4 story building (that looks like a giant "Belgian Waffle") on the left, opposite the bus stop.
- The Family Research Lab/Crimes against Children Research Center is in Suite 125 on the first floor of the building.

## **PARKING**

1. Visitor parking permits must be obtained from the Visitor Information Center (see Campus Visit Guide and Map enclosed or if this is sent via e-mail see [www.unh.edu/parking/visitors.html](http://www.unh.edu/parking/visitors.html) for visitor information).
2. There are a few metered parking spaces on the same side of the street from McConnell, but a space is rare.
3. There is a big parking Lot "B" just before you get to McConnell, which has spaces in the PM, but can be full in the AM. (NOTE: if you do not have a permit to park there, you run the risk of getting a \$30 parking ticket!)
4. There is metered parking in Lot "C", on Mill Road, across from the Durham Shopping Plaza, back toward town. If you park there, the way to McConnell involves: heading straight up the hill in the back of Lot "C"; going past a pedestrian bridge that leads to the Memorial Union Building (MUB); making a left turn next to the dorm across from the MUB until you come out into College Road, and proceeding right along College Road to McConnell.

**FROM LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (BOS) BOSTON MA**

Logan International Airport in Boston is approximately 60 miles from Durham. Leave the Airport on Route 1 going North and look for the Route 95 Exit. Once on I-95 going North, drive approximately 35 minutes across the NH border and through one toll (\$1).

As you approach Portsmouth, New Hampshire, take Exit 4 on your left ("White Mtns./Dover"). You will now be on the Spaulding Turnpike heading North. Drive approximately 5 miles to Exit 6 West (Route 4 West/Durham/UNH). It's the last exit before a toll and you will see the toll booth as you take the exit. Follow Route 4 West approximately 4 miles past the UNH/Durham Route 108 exit and through one traffic light. About 1/2 mile after the light, take the Route 155A Exit (UNH/Durham). At the stop sign, turn left (going east) towards downtown Durham on 155A (Main Street).

Go less than a quarter-mile on 155A and take the second right turn, which is 10 West Edge Drive. At the top of the hill is a STOP sign. 10 West Edge is the first building on the right (Printing and Mail Services). Immediately to your left is S-Lot, parking for Faculty and Staff. A parking permit has been acquired for you. This can be picked up in the office and this will need to be placed in your car.

**Directions from Manchester Airport, Manchester, NH.**

From the airport, follow signs to highway 293 (you'll be on Brown Ave. for approx. 1 mile). Then take 293 South (right on-ramp before the overpass) to 93 North. Exit onto Route 101 East and stay on that for about 20 miles. Exit at Route 125 exit; turn left at bottom of ramp (125 North). Proceed for about 10 miles to traffic circle; take first exit of traffic circle, which will be Route 4 East (towards Durham). Follow Route 4 for approximately 1.5 miles to Route 155A (UNH/Durham); bear right at the end of the ramp.

Go less than a quarter-mile on 155A and take the second right turn, which is 10 West Edge Drive. At the top of the hill is a STOP sign. 10 West Edge is the first building on the right (Printing and Mail Services). Immediately to your left is S-Lot, parking for Faculty and Staff. A parking permit has been acquired for you. This can be picked up in the office and this will need to be placed in your car.

**Directions to UNH, Crimes against Children Research Center, 10 West Edge Dr (formerly 7 Leavitt Lane) , Durham, NH**

**From Boston, Mass.**

Take I-95 North to Exit 4 (NH Lakes and Mountains, Spaulding Turnpike). Continue North to Exit 6W and follow Route 4 West past the UNH/Durham Route 108 exit. Exit at Route 155A and turn east toward Durham. Take second right up the hill to the Printing and Mail Service Building, Room 106.

**From Portland, Me.**

Follow I-95 South to Exit 5. Continue on Spaulding Turnpike North to Exit 6W and follow Route 4 West. Follow directions as listed from Boston.

**From Concord, NH**

Take Route 4 East to the 155A exit. Follow directions as listed from Boston.

**From Manchester, NH**

Take Route 101 to Epping; go north on Route 125 to the Lee Traffic Circle. Drive east on Route 4 to the Route 155A exit. Follow directions as listed from Boston.
