Motion: The Faculty Senate is grateful to the Discovery Review Committee for taking on the task of reviewing the state of our general education program in 2019 and for their recommendations to improve the current program. The DRC process was interrupted by a global pandemic, which continues, and the initial DRC recommendations were revised to respond to calls for greater emphasis on diversity and inclusion. The context at UNH has changed significantly since the DRC process began in 2019; therefore, the Faculty Senate instructs the Agenda Committee to form an ad hoc committee to reassess the DRC recommendations to UNH's general education curriculum.

The Agenda Committee will draft the parameters for committee membership and the specific committee goals and timeline and share these with the Senate for approval.

4. Senate Action: The motion was put to a vote on April 19. The motion passed with 36 in favor, 19 opposed, and 2 abstentions.
