**Download the UNH Mobile App**

**Upload your immigration documents to your eOISS Portal**

**Buy things for your apartment or room** - Make sure you have bedding, toiletries, and any items you want to make UNH feel like home

**Log into MyUNH** - [my.unh.edu](http://my.unh.edu)  
Here you will find links to MyCourses, your UNH email, Webcat, and many others

**Check your UNH email at least a few times per day**

**Log into MyCourses (Canvas) to check course syllabi and announcements**

**Log into WildcatLink to find student organizations and upcoming events**

**Log into Webcat** - Make sure you have paid student fees and there are no “holds” on your account

**Learn where and how to do laundry** - if you live on-campus, dorms have laundry rooms

**Learn how to put Cat’s Cache on your UNH ID** - you will need to do this for laundry in the residence halls. Find the link through MyUNH

**“Pat the Cat”** - touch the Wildcat Statue’s nose and get a photo while you are there
