## CHECK-LIST

- ☐ **Shut and lock all windows**
- ☐ Clean out your fridge and cabinets
- ☐ **Empty dressers, desks, bathroom mirrors and cabinets**
- ☐ Wipe surfaces, sweep and mop
- ☐ Donate any unwanted items to the **Trash-to-Treasure** drop off at the Community Center\*\*
- ☐ **Take out the trash \*\***
- ☐ Check inside and under furniture for lost items
- ☐ **Drop off your key at the Woodside Mail Room**
- ☐ Complete the online Self Check-Out on the UNH Housing Portal

### For all graduating students:

# NAVIGATING THE HOUSING PORTAL: **SELF CHECK-OUT**

Your access to your building will be immediately turned off upon completion of the online form.

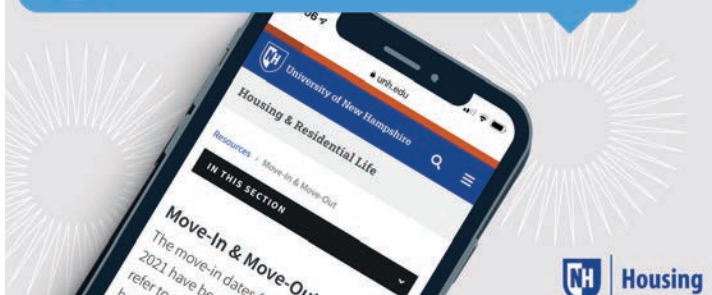
