- Clean out your fridge and cabinets
- Empty dressers, desks, bathroom mirrors and cabinets
- Wipe surfaces, sweep and mop
- Donate any unwanted items to the **Trash-to-Treasure** drop off at the Community Center**
- Take out the trash **
- Check inside and under furniture for lost items
- Drop off your key at the Woodside Mail Room
- Out on the UNH Housing Portal

Your access to your building will be immediately turned off upon completion of the online form.




