Subject: Salary Increase, January 2018

It has been another great year for the University of New Hampshire. Every one of you has played a role in our success, and I am pleased to recognize your hard work and commitment with a salary increase for eligible non-union employees effective Jan. 1, 2018: an across the board increase of 1 percent and a merit/equity pool of 2 percent.

The doors on a renovated and expanded Hamilton Smith Hall opened, 414 first-year New Hampshire students are attending UNH tuition-free, and our place as a national leader in sustainability was affirmed when we became one of only three higher education institutions in the world to earn the STARS platinum rating.
