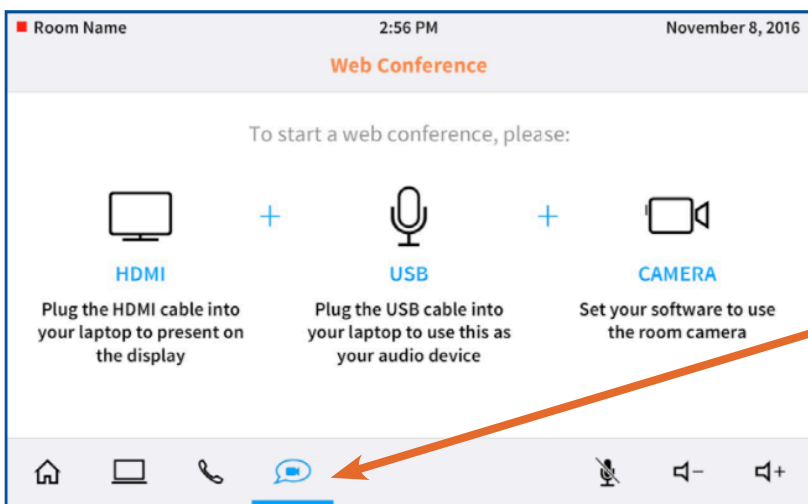




Crestron Mercury™

Run a Web Conference via the Crestron Mercury™



****Turn on your computer and connect to the University WIFI***

1. Tap the symbol that looks like a camera in a chat bubble. This will display the Web Conference screen.



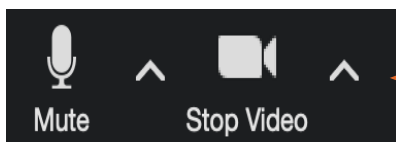
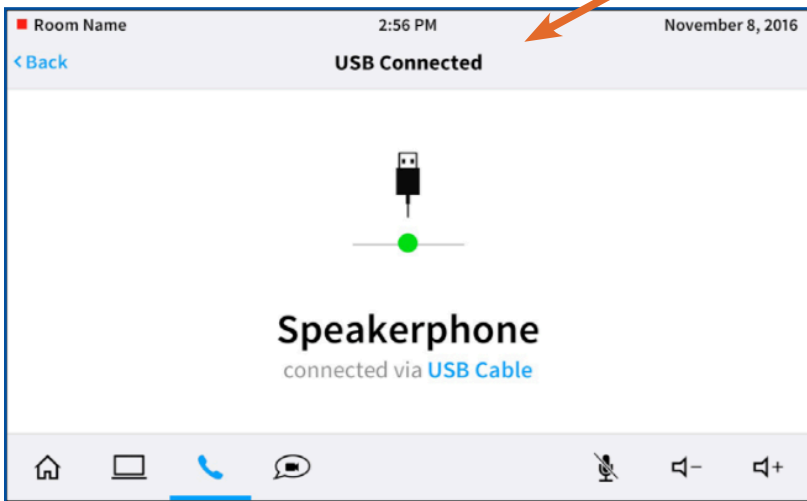

2. Connect the HDMI cable (typically located near the Mercury™ system or the in table units) to the computer that is running the web conference.



USB

3. Connect the USB cable (typically located near the Mercury™ system or the in table units) to the computer that is hosting the web conference. the 'USB Connected' screen will then display.

4. On the computer, set the web conference software (Ex: Zoom) to use the room camera and microphone by clicking on the ^ and selecting 'Crestron Mercury' from the pulled up menu. You will need to select both the microphone and camera separately.
