

uSafeUS Research Assistant

Job Description

Prevention Innovations Research Center (PIRC) is seeking three undergraduate or graduate students to help with PIRC's NH VOCA Grant Project for 10-15 hours/week. The objective of the NH VOCA Grant is to facilitate the successful implementation of PIRC's uSafeUS mobile app on the 24 NH college campuses. This student should be interested in the field of sexual and relationship violence prevention and response. This position has the potential to be a full year, and can begin over Summer if desired by the applicant. Applicants from all towns in the state of NH are encouraged to apply.

Responsibilities:

- Keep uSafeUS communications accounts updated daily (Facebook) and weekly (Instagram)
- Post updates, news and announcements in a timely manner using appropriate content
- Create images and flyers to be used on campuses and on social media
- Drive to and attend tabling events at NH campuses to promote uSafeUS
- Work with the uSafeUS VOCA Grant Project Manager and Coordinator to facilitate focus groups with students at the NH campuses
- Assist with data entry and analytics
- Attend weekly uSafeUS VOCA Grant meetings, in-person or via web-call

Requirements:

- Creativity, enthusiasm and a friendly personality a must!
- Interest in the PIRC mission of ending sexual and relationship violence and stalking
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to work well with others and collaborate effectively
- Experience with Facebook and Instagram
- Prior research experience a plus
