About the Position: The Sharon B. Murphy Internship was established for students with an expressed interest and passion for working in the field of sexual and relationship violence and stalking prevention and response, and who possess strong writing skills and an interest in research. The position includes:

- 10 hours/week for the Fall semester as a researcher-in-training in the Susan Schechter Domestic and Sexual Violence Social Justice Lab at UNH's Prevention Innovations Research Center.
- Training in data collection, entry and analysis and in writing professional reports and articles for publication.
- Opportunities for collaboration with PIRC researchers to co-author reports and publications and/or present at workshops/conferences.
- Mentorship by Prevention Innovations Research Center researchers.
- This internship is funded by the Sharon B Murphy Scholarship Award. The award is approximately \$2,000, the exact amount will be determined in May 2023.

- Full-time UNH student who is a junior, senior, or graduate student with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Demonstrated interest in the field of sexual and relationship violence and stalking prevention and response
- Outstanding writing skills and interest in research
