

UNH FACULTY SENATE
MOTION #XXII-M11
on retiring Booklist in favor of FacultyEnlight

1. Motion presenter: John Gibson

2. Dates of Faculty Senate discussion: 2/26/2018, 4/16/2018, 4/30/2018

3. Rationale: This motion was drafted by the Information Technology Committee in response to a charge from the Agenda Committee of the Faculty Senate to review the FacultyEnlight course materials adoption tool as a replacement for UNH's Booklist system.

- Whereas UNH currently employs two distinct software systems for placing orders for textbooks and other course materials;
- Whereas the UNH Bookstore, Business Services, and Academic Technology recommend that the UNH Booklist system be retired and book orders be consolidated on FacultyEnlight, in order to eliminate redundancy, reduce workload on Academic Technology, and increase the sales at the UNH Bookstore;
- Whereas the UNH Bookstore returns a portion of its sales to the UNH Library (\$71,000 in fiscal year 2017).
- Whereas many faculty appreciate the Durham Book Exchange flexibility and responsiveness when courses book lists change frequently and at the last minute;
- The Information Technology Committee submits the following motion:

4. Motion: The Faculty Senate accepts the termination of UNH Academic Technology's Booklist in favor of consolidation on Barnes & Noble's FacultyEnlight as the sole software system for registering book orders with the UNH Bookstore, starting with courses in Fall of 2018. The Senate appreciates the role of the Durham Book Exchange as a supplementary source of course materials and recommends that all UNH book orders continue to be forwarded regularly to the Durham Book Exchange.
