What is the cost to participate in Family Weekend?

- Family Weekend includes presentations, demonstrations and health and wellness classes that can all be attended for FREE! If you would like to attend the BBQ and football game in Wildcat Stadium on Saturday, or the breakfast in the Service Credit Union Victory Club on Sunday, tickets must be purchased in advance. Will there be a cutoff date for buying tickets, or can I purchase tickets right up to September 28?

- The cutoff date to purchase tickets for the BBQ and breakfast is **Friday, September 20 at 5:00 p.m.** Tickets for the game can still be purchased on the day of the event at the Box Office in Wildcat Stadium.

Can I eat in the dining hall with my student?

Is there programming for younger siblings?

- We do not offer specific programming for younger children, but they should find many of the Family Weekend activities interesting and entertaining. There is also special youth pricing offered at the Family Weekend BBQ and football game for kids under 12.

Can my student sit with me at the football game?

- UNH undergraduate students are supplied with general admission football tickets as part of their activities fee. The Family Weekend package extends general admission access for families to sit with their students on the Field House side of Wildcat Stadium.

Where does tailgating take place before the football game?

- UNH fans with a game ticket can enjoy tailgating in either Boulder Lot or A Lot. Limited parking is available for pre-purchase in both locations. UNH's tailgating policies can be found online at <https://bit.ly/2Zwk53G>.

Parking

- Special Game Day Parking is not included in the Family Weekend package, but can be purchased for A Lot or Boulder Lot, which are in close proximity to Wildcat Stadium. Additional parking (without tailgating or extra charge) can be found in B Lot, Strafford Avenue Lot or the Eliot Alumni Center Lot.

Can my student pick up my tickets for me prior to the check in time on Saturday?

- Game tickets and the bracelets for access to all Family Weekend activities will not be ready for distribution until Saturday morning from 8:00-11:00 am on the Great Lawn in front of Thompson Hall.

If it is raining will Family Weekend activities be cancelled?

- Family Weekend will take place rain or shine. Please keep an eye on the weather and plan accordingly. There are no refunds.

My plans have changed and I will not be able to attend, can I get my money back?
