On the Resignation of José Calvo as Senate Speaker

DURHAM, NH– The Student Senate is saddened to announce the sudden and unexpected resignation of José Calvo as the Speaker of the Student Senate. José will be leaving the position due to personal reasons, and Parliamentarian Douglas Marino will serve as Interim Speaker until the Senate holds elections at its next meeting on February 25th.

The Student Senate would like to express its gratitude to Speaker Calvo for his service to the Student Body and his time in the Senate. During his tenure, Calvo laid the groundwork for a successful 2018 General Election with an overhaul of election policies, including provisions on fighting campaign corruption. Calvo also formed initiatives to tackle how the Student Senate interacts with the Student Body itself through reforms to its public relations and communication. While Speaker Calvo is saddened to be leaving the position, he will continue to act as a resource to students in the forthcoming months, and we would like to thank him for his work as Speaker.
