- New Honors College for top students

- Student Emergency Fund supported by 500+ community members

Expand Academic and Research Excellence

- Carnegie R1 rated, the highest in higher ed.
- Record \$260 million in competitive research grants
- New Global Racial and Social Inequality Lab
- \$3.5 million grant will encourage English-learners in Manchester's K-12 school to STEM learning
- Franklin Pierce School of Law: No. 4 in US for intellectual property law



Embrace New Hampshire

- 5,000+ NH businesses assisted each year
