

MOTION PASSED  
IN THE FACULTY SENATE MEETING  
OF APRIL 7 1997

The General Education Committee (composed of one faculty member from each college, except Liberal Arts with two members, and a representative from each of the Registrar's and Admissions Offices, with the Vice President for Academic Affairs serving as chair) has the authority to decide whether or not a particular course from some other university or college will be accepted for a General Education requirement. For transfer credits to meet General Education requirements, courses must be reviewed and approved by the Admissions Office with the advice and consent of the General Education Committee. Previously approved courses may be reconsidered periodically by the General Education Committee.
