

FACULTY SENATE MOTION II-M6
SECOND MOTION ON TRANSFER OF OTHER CREDITS

Text of Motion :

The Academic Affairs Committee moves that the following policy on the transfer of credits designated as "Other" by the Admissions Office be adopted by the Faculty Senate:

The transfer of course credits from the New Hampshire community Technical Colleges shall follow the current procedures and agreements used by the Admissions Office. When the New Hampshire Community Technical Colleges complete their transition to the New England Association of Schools and Colleges, Commission on Institutions of Higher Education, transfer credits shall be processed in accordance with Motion II-M5 (Transfer of Other Credits).

Rationale:

The New Hampshire Community Technical Colleges are undergoing a transformation in which their accrediting agency will be shifted. Until that shift is completed, the Academic Affairs Committee believes that the status quo of transfer of course credit should remain undisturbed. This motion is intended as a place holder. Once the transformation has taken place, transfer of course credit for the category of Other Accepted Courses shall be reviewed in accordance with the policy established in Motion II-M5.
