**3. Rationale:**


The implementation of the Discovery Program was endorsed by the Faculty Senate in the spring of 2009. Planning discussions at that time included a proposal for a program review in five years. The Discovery Program is now in its fifth year and data are available for a meaningful review.

**4. Motion:**

The Faculty Senate endorses a review of the Discovery Program. The Faculty Senate will form an ad hoc review committee which will have faculty representatives from each college and UNH-Manchester. The committee membership will include at least one faculty senator and at least one faculty member of the Discovery Program Committee. The Faculty Senate will invite the Director of the Discovery Program, and selected non-faculty members who could contribute to the review, to serve on the committee. The Agenda Committee will establish the goals of the ad hoc committee. The review committee will report its findings and recommendations to the Faculty Senate by the end of March 2015.
