

INCO 590/INCO 790 Comparison Chart

| Description/Requirements | INCO 590 | INCO 790 |

| Purpose | Entry-level, apprenticeship experience; designed to help students develop research skills and prepare for more advanced research. | Advanced-level experience; designed for students who are conducting more advanced research and applying research skills they already have developed. |
| Student Eligibility | Students enrolled in a UNH associate or baccalaureate degree program. Students must be in good academic standing. | Students enrolled in a UNH baccalaureate degree program, especially: students who have already taken INCO 590; who have already conducted research; or who have had significant preparatory coursework. Students must be in good academic standing. |
| Registration | Follows University add/drop deadline. Signed Student-Faculty Contract must be submitted to Hamel Center. | |
| Course Credit | 1-4 credits per semester; may be repeated for up to 8 credits maximum (INCO 590 + INCO 790 combined) toward bachelor's degree. Students may not work on more than one INCO 590 or INCO 790 project in any one semester. | |
| Support for Expenses | Up to \$200 for research expenses per semester. | |
| Grading | Credit/Fail | Assigned letter grade |
| Faculty Mentor Eligibility | A faculty member may mentor no more than five students per semester under INCO 590 and 790 combined. Read further guidelines on faculty mentor eligibility . | |
