An Outstanding Mentor is

- An excellent classroom teacher
- A dedicated professional who is consistently engaged in his/her own professional development and values the role of inquiry and reflection in learning and teaching;
- Possesses exemplary mentoring skills: cares deeply about students and colleagues; is appropriately supportive and challenging; creates spaces for interns to develop their own teaching identity and philosophy; initiates and encourages dialogue about his/her own practice and decision-making.

The Process:

A committee of faculty members from Teacher Education will review the applications and identify 5-10 finalists. The committee will then contact the UNH supervisor and building principal for additional information regarding the nominee. A winner will be determined by April 4th, 2016 and the award presented at UNH Education Program Presentation on May 6, 2016 at UNH Manchester.
