TICKETS

Tickets are required for entry to the Whittemore Center Arena. Each student will be able to claim up to **4** tickets when they register to walk in the ceremony.

Tickets will be **emailed** in late April or Early May.

Tickets are **not transferable** and all guests in a party will need to arrive at the same time to the Whittemore Center for entry.

TICKET LOTTERY

Students have the opportunity to enter a **lottery** for additional tickets when they register to walk in the ceremony.

The lottery will be completed on Wednesday, **April 16th** and all students will be notified by Wednesday, April 23rd.

The lottery will be drawn at **random** and all students have the same opportunity to receive additional tickets regardless of how many additional tickets they request.





LIVE STREAM AND OVERFLOW SEATING

Each ceremony will be **streamed live** for those who would like to watch from home or those who want to enjoy the celebratory environment of campus by viewing the commencement ceremony in the Field House, a designated overflow seating area within easy walking distance of the Whittemore Center Arena.

PHOTO AND VIDEO

Each graduate will receive one **free photo** of themselves crossing the stage. Additional photos and video will be available for purchase.

ARRIVAL AND PARKING

Guests should plan to arrive I hour prior to the scheduled start of the ceremony. Doors to the Whittemore Center will open at this time.

ADA accessible shuttle buses will only be running from the assigned

lots during that ceremony.

Guests with ADA placards on their car can park at the Elliott Alumni

SEATING

The **top rows** of seating is reserved for guests with other mobility challenges.





POST EVENT

Graduates and families should arrange for a **meet up** location after the ceremony. Students will exit through the rear of the building as soon as the ceremony ends and will be directed to the front of the Whittemore Center. Guests will exit through the front doors. Ceremonies will last approximately 90 minutes. We recommend allocating an additional hour before booking reservations particularly for those outside of Durham.
