ATTIRE

While there's no dress code for what to wear under your gown, most graduates like to wear **something nice** to celebrate the occasion. Be mindful of your **footwear** as you'll be doing a lot of walking and standing on concrete. Gowns needed to be **zipped**.



LINE UP

Arrive at the Hamel Rec Center **1** hour prior to the start of the ceremony. You'll check in, grab a "name card" and then get in line. Faculty and staff will be on hand to help!

SEATING

Graduates are seated **alphabetically** by college and by degree type. This is to make it easier for your families to catch your big moment when you walk across the stage!



NAME CARDS

When you check in, you'll be given a **card** with your name on it and a QR code. Hang on to this card! You'll be asked for it when you walk across the stage. Faculty will be on hand to let you know when it's time to cross the stage!

PHOTO AND VIDEO

Each graduate will receive one **free photo** of themselves crossing the stage. Additional photos and video will be available for purchase.
